### 1.Purpose

The Eastern Cape Liquor Board invites suitable qualified service providers to submit quotations with regards to provision of a 2x Laptops.

Its mandate is to regulate the registration of retail sales and micromanufacturing of liquor and support the industry in the management and reduction of negative socio-economic impacts caused by the alcohol abuse and to promote new entrants into the industry.

- 4..4Prospective service providers are advised that submission of bids give rise to no contractual obligations on the part of ECLB.
- 4.2 All bids shall become the property of ECLB and shall not be returned.
- 4.3 The successful service provider will sign a Service Level Agreement.
- 4.4 Service Providers should register in the National Treasury Central Supplier Database. Tax compliance PIN CODE from the SARS is required and should be provided by the service provider.
- 4.5 Electronic quotations shall be accepted.
- 4.6 SBD 6.1 for the Specific goals must be submitted. Service providers must submit the SBD4 and SBD 6.1 form together with their quotations.
